All the children succeeded with these challenges as they immersed themselves in a range of fantastic activities including gorge walking, rambling, kayaking, abseiling to name but a few. The children thoroughly engaged in all the activities and relished the challenge of trying something new and unfamiliar to them. For the first time we introduced a 'no sweet policy'. I am pleased to report that this had a dramatic effect on the quality of behaviour. All our children slept better, were more focused, they ate very well at scheduled mealtimes and hardly any conflicts or outbursts occurred. The instructors remarked how good their behaviour was at all times.
