I would like to start by saying a huge thank you! The Sports Partnership, as always, has been a big success this year; we couldn't have done it without you.

I have attached the data for this academic year. We have once again achieved over 3,000 students attending sports festivals including level 1, 2 and 3. This year we have had approximately 3100 children attend festivals; of which 255 children progressed onto level 2 competitions and 30 children successfully progressed onto level 3 Competition. Over all approximately 450 leaders have been used to assist and run the festivals.

Well done to Eden Park for getting through to 10 Level 2 competitions and 2 level 3 Competitions and also to St Margret Clitherow for getting through to 2 level 2 competitions and 1 Level 3 competitions.

Included are the figures for the level 2 curriculum support sessions. Brixham College has provided approximately 200 sessions for our level 2 schools supported by various members of staff within the Healthy Living Faculty and coaches and 100 sessions for our Level 1 schools, all in all a total of near 300 sessions for Brixham and Churston Schools. Our aim is to develop a sustainable programme which helps support and develop staff confidence and knowledge within PE enabling more young people to receive high quality PE and Sport within their Primary Curriculum.

We have tried to use wider links with the community this year by using venues such as the Velopark, Brixham Cricket Club and Berry Head. We have also had the pleasure of Ms Bowden-Williams delivering fantastic technology sessions for all schools.

You will be pleased to know that for state schools, doubling of Sports Premium has been confirmed as below, however, the formula has not been disclosed and we won't find exactly the amount until September, however this is still great news for you as you will definitely see and increase in sports premium funding.
